As a Volunteer with George House Trust you'll be playing a key role in challenging HIV stigma and raising awareness about HIV in the community. This is a great opportunity to join a dynamic team of volunteers.</p> <p>Key tasks include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Speaking to the public about HIV as part of a team at information stalls and events ▪ Distributing publicity materials to community venues ▪ Fundraising on behalf of the charity at events, distributing red ribbons and carrying out charity collections. ▪ Attending volunteer meetings, to generate new ideas and contacts to help increase awareness raising and fundraising activities. ▪ Support George House Trust at larger events such as Manchester Pride and World AIDS Day
Time Commitment	You will be informed of upcoming events and then select the ones you would like to attend. There are a number of daytime events but evening, weekend and late-night events are common in this volunteer role too.
Location	This volunteer activity is all about getting information about HIV out into the community. Volunteering could take place anywhere in Greater Manchester.
